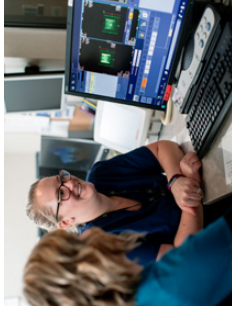
Hands-on experiences will include observation of PET/MR acquisitions along with activities designed to explore the functionality of our Time-of-flight PET/MR scanner.
